## Introduction

Data analysis included descriptive statistics as well as content analysis procedures derived from both the open-ended questions and close-ended questions based on the partners' responses to the evaluation questionnaires.

The data analysis was based in a sample of 14 responses. All seven (7) organizations were represented by at least one meeting participant.

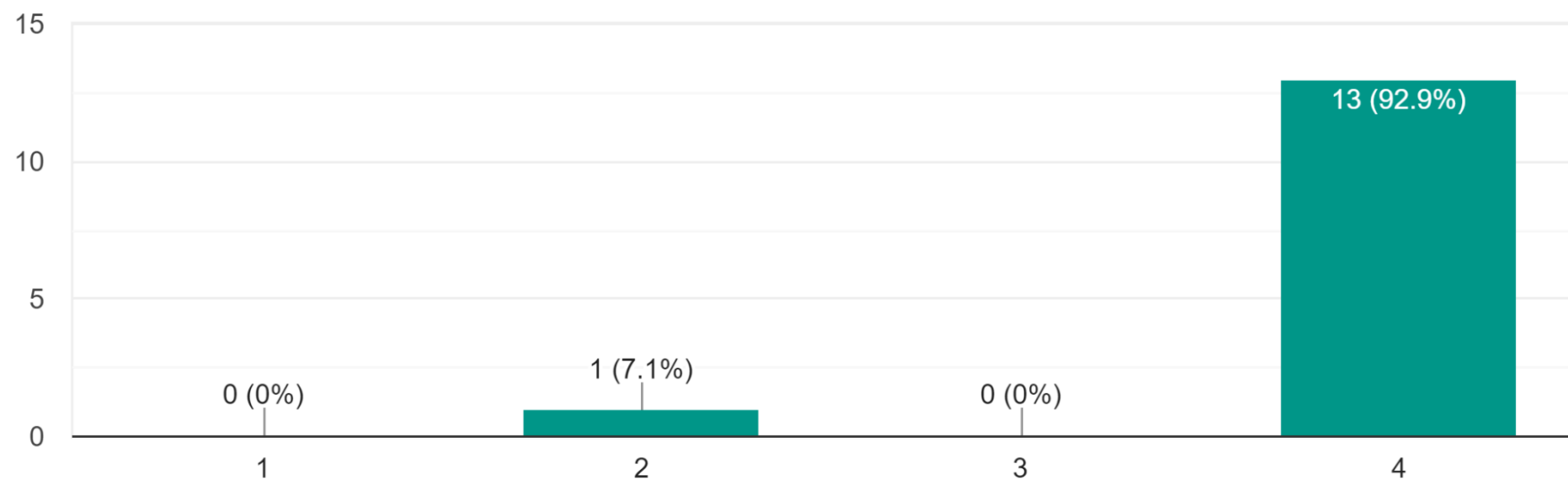

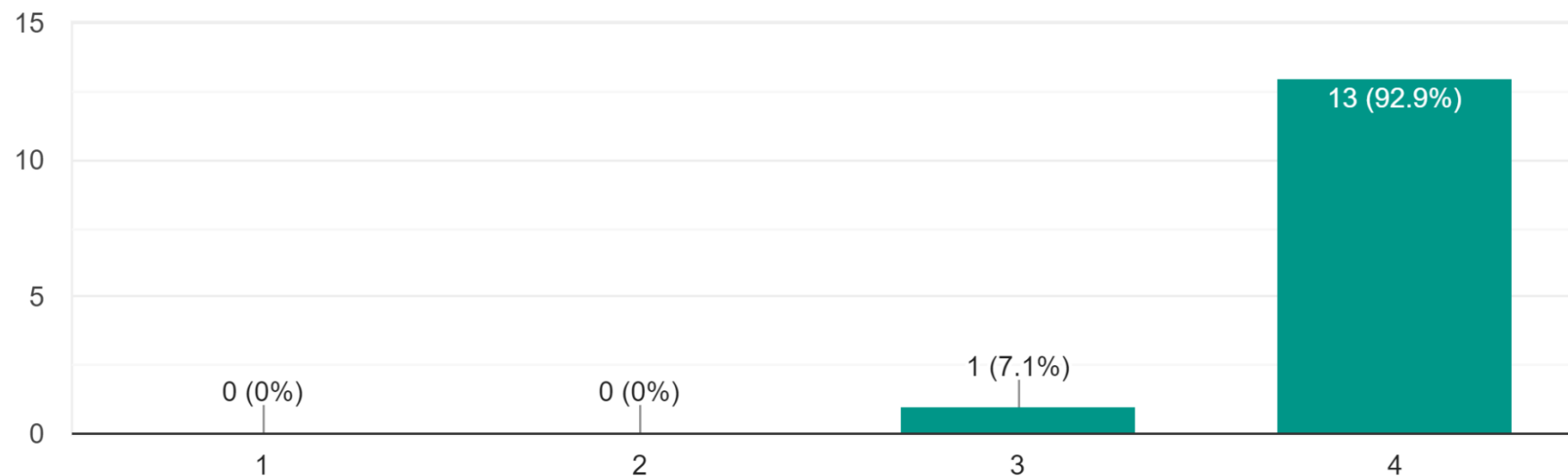

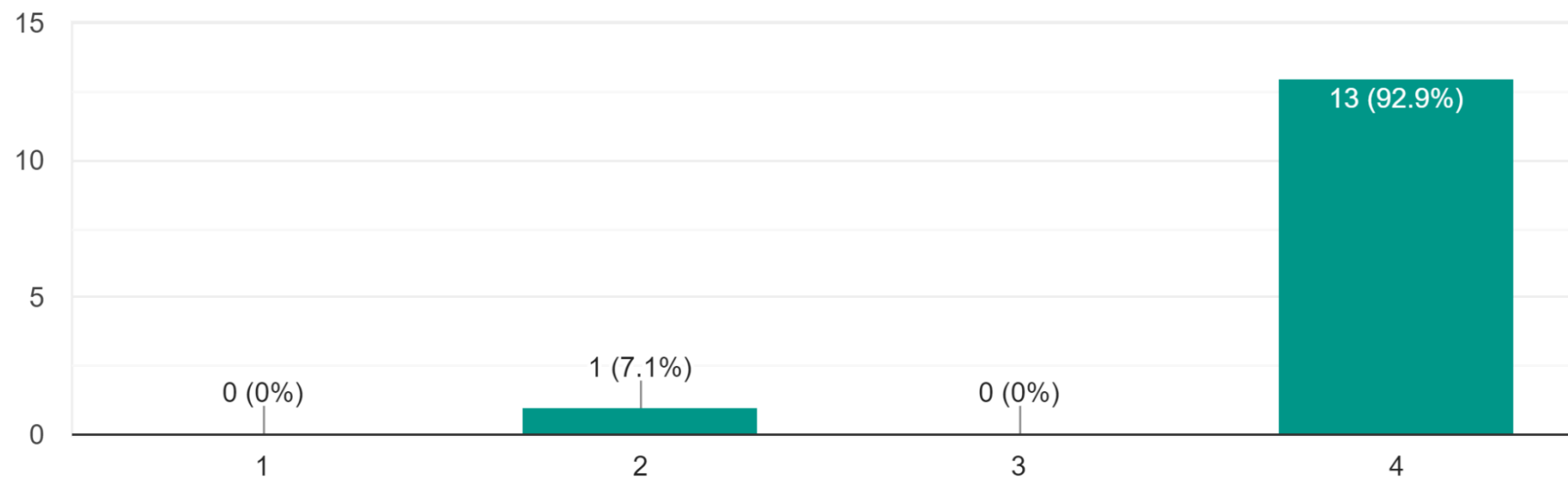

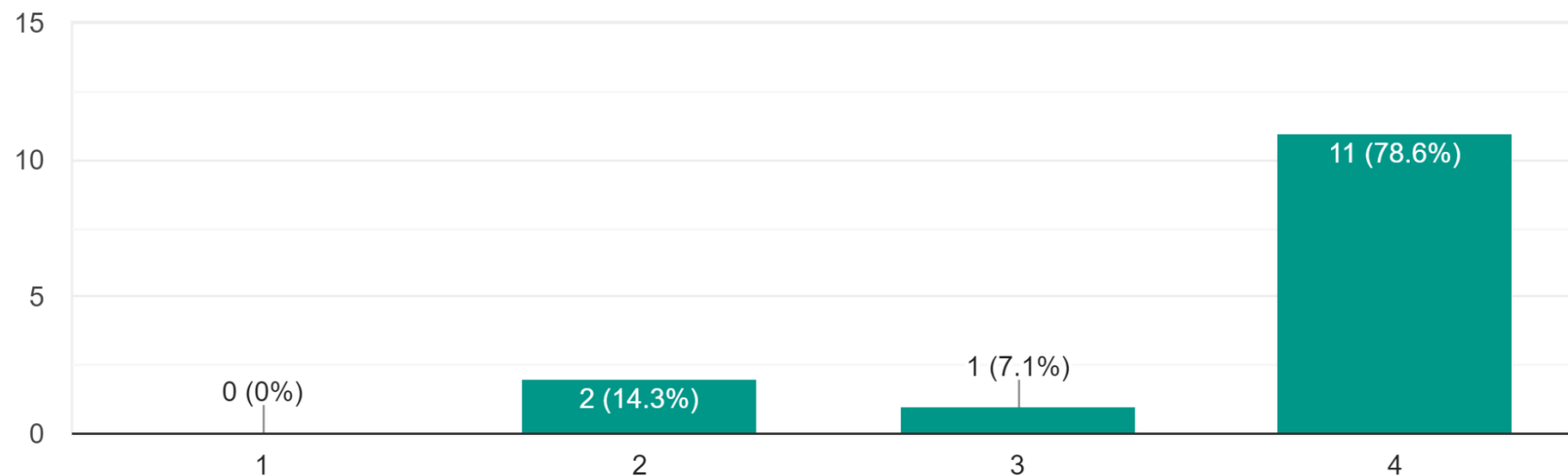

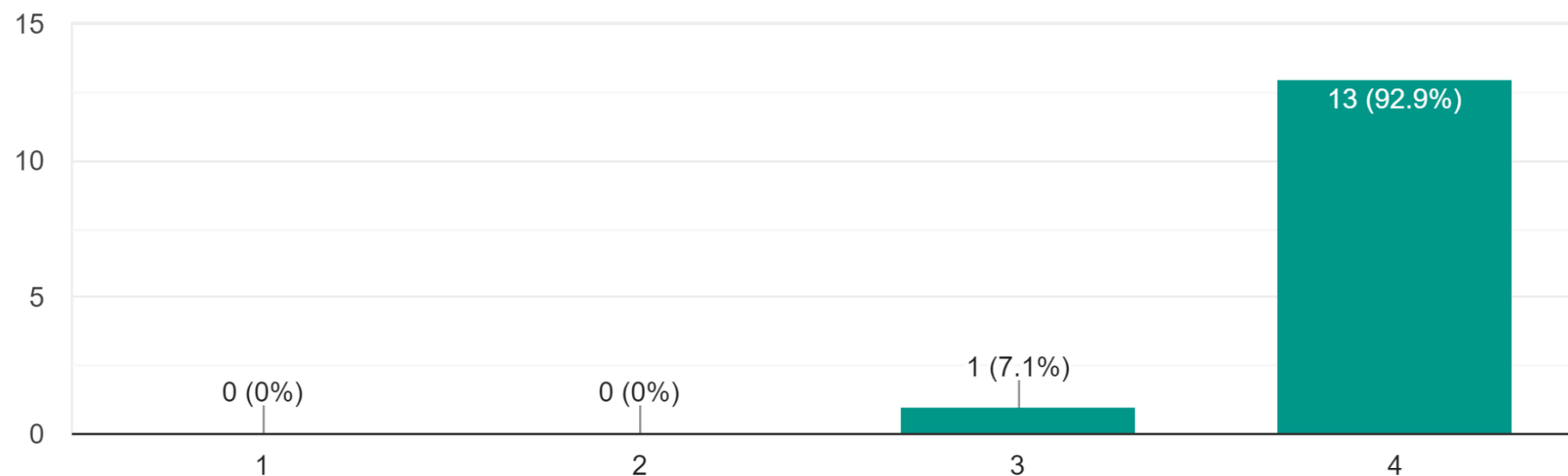

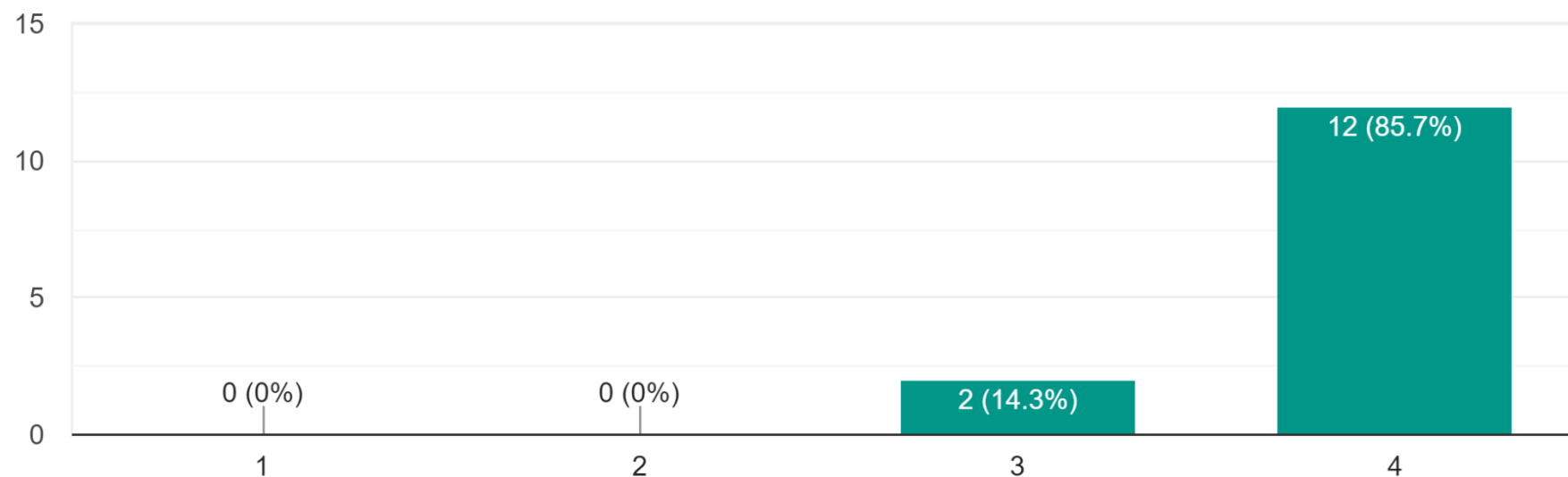

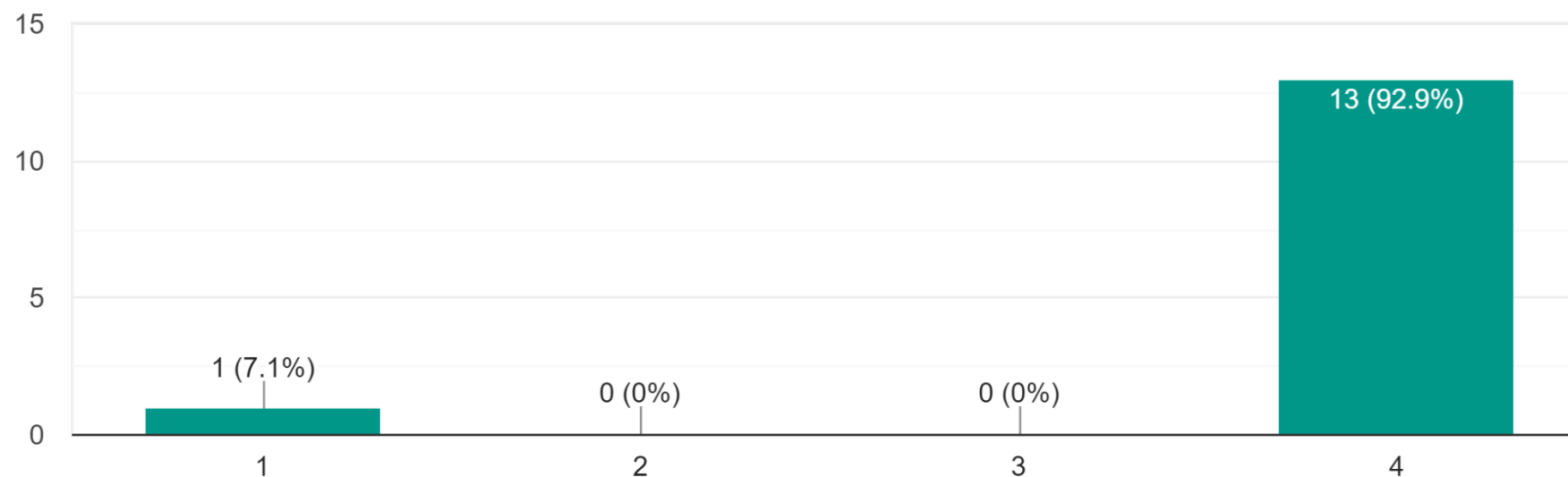

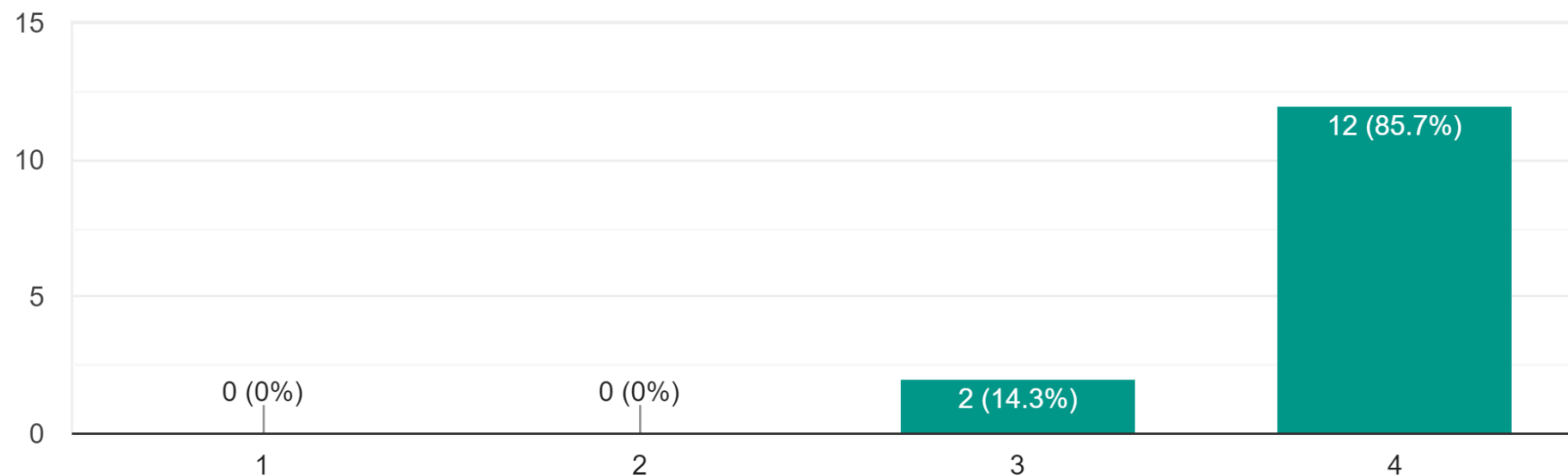

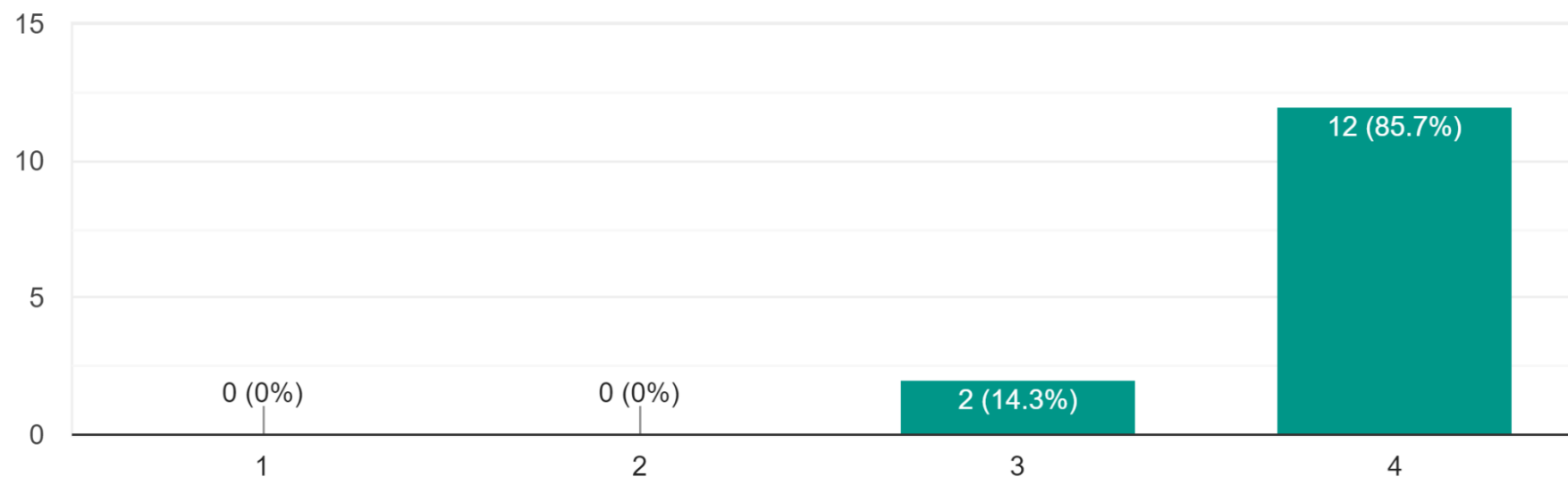

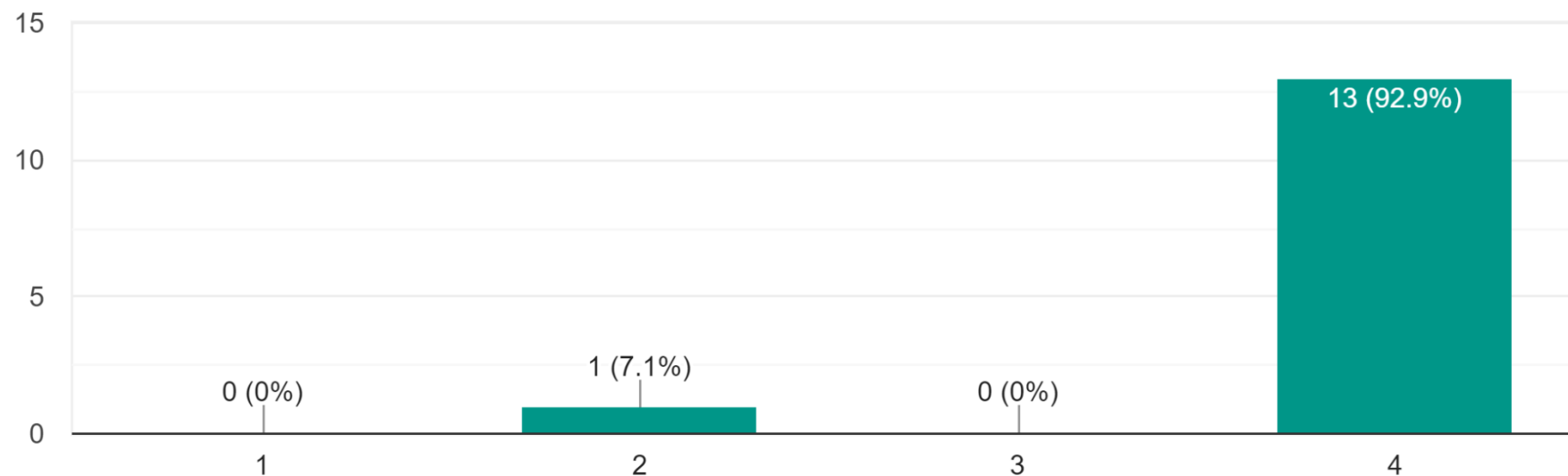

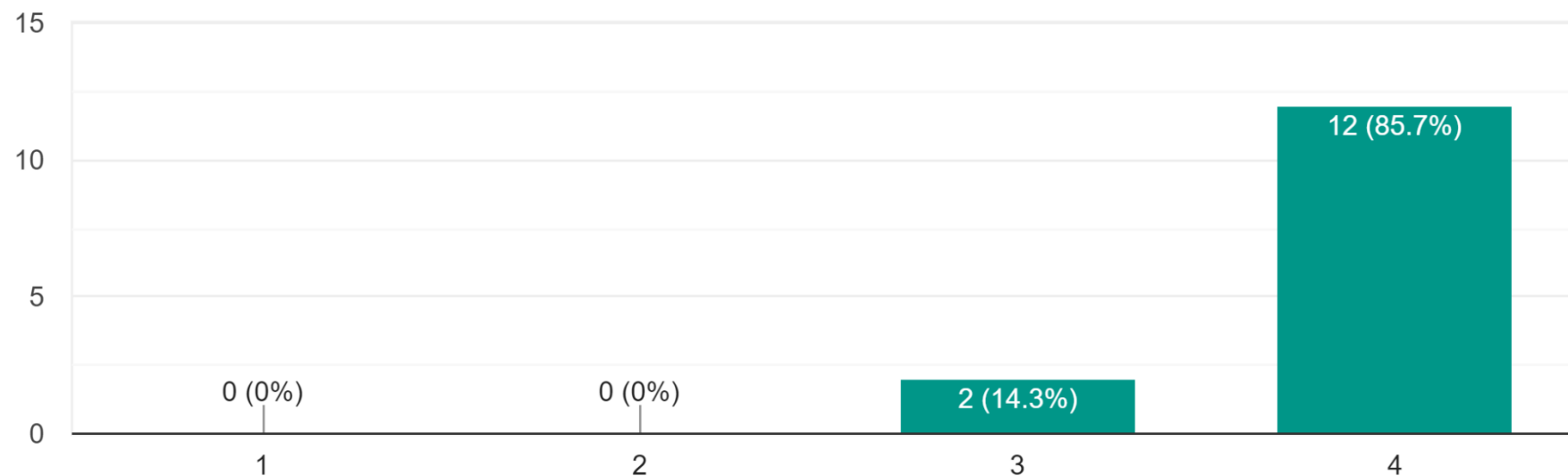

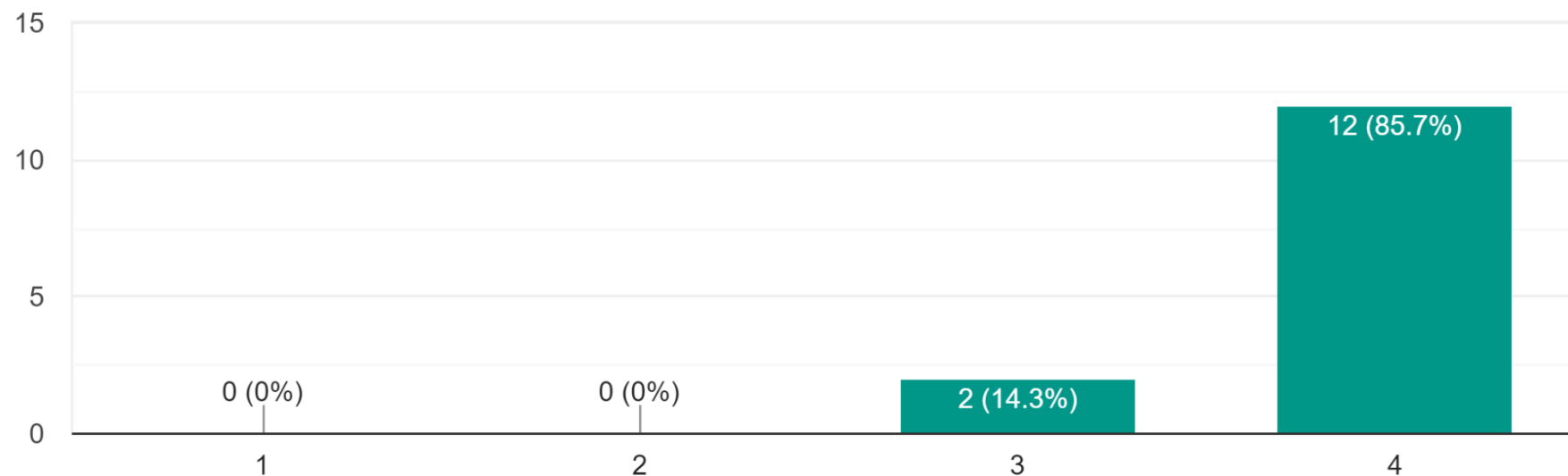

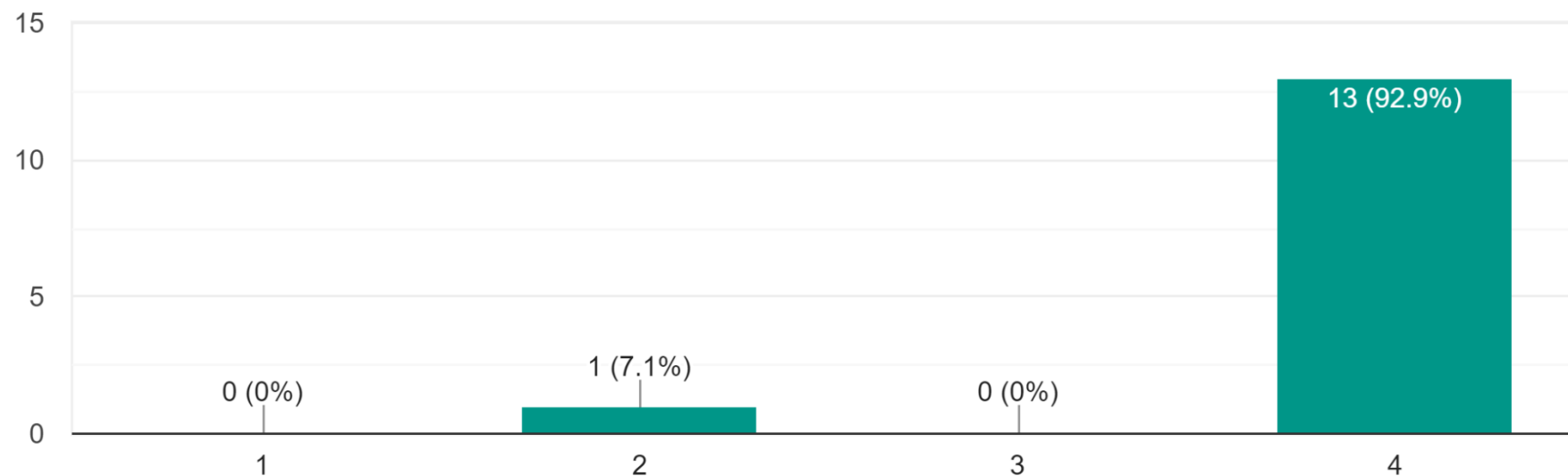

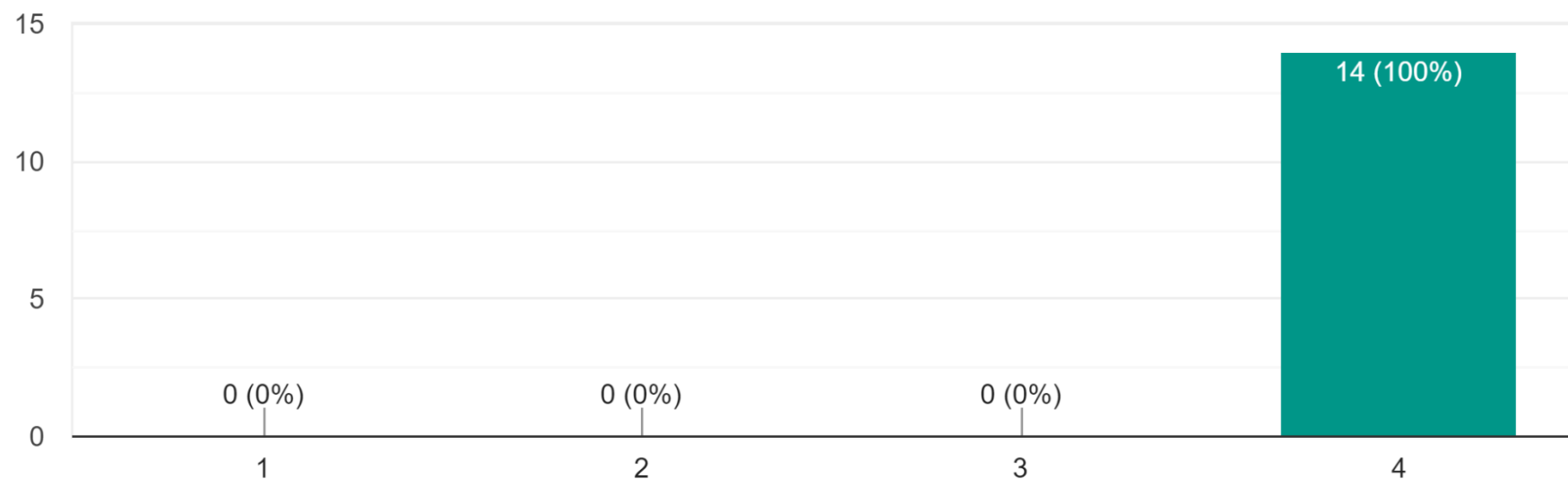

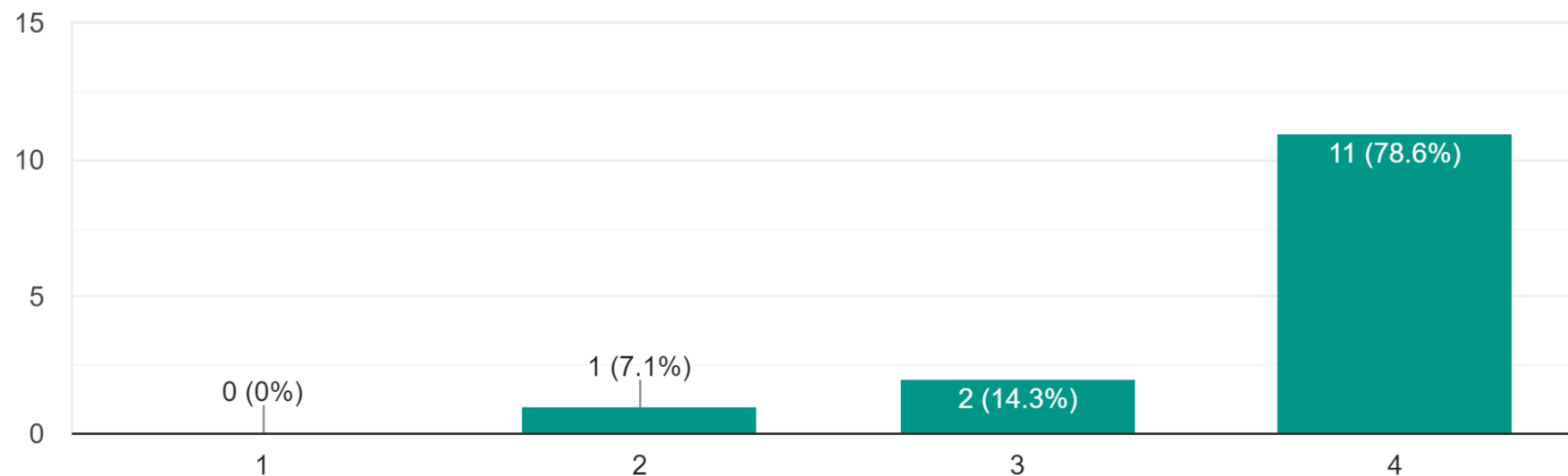

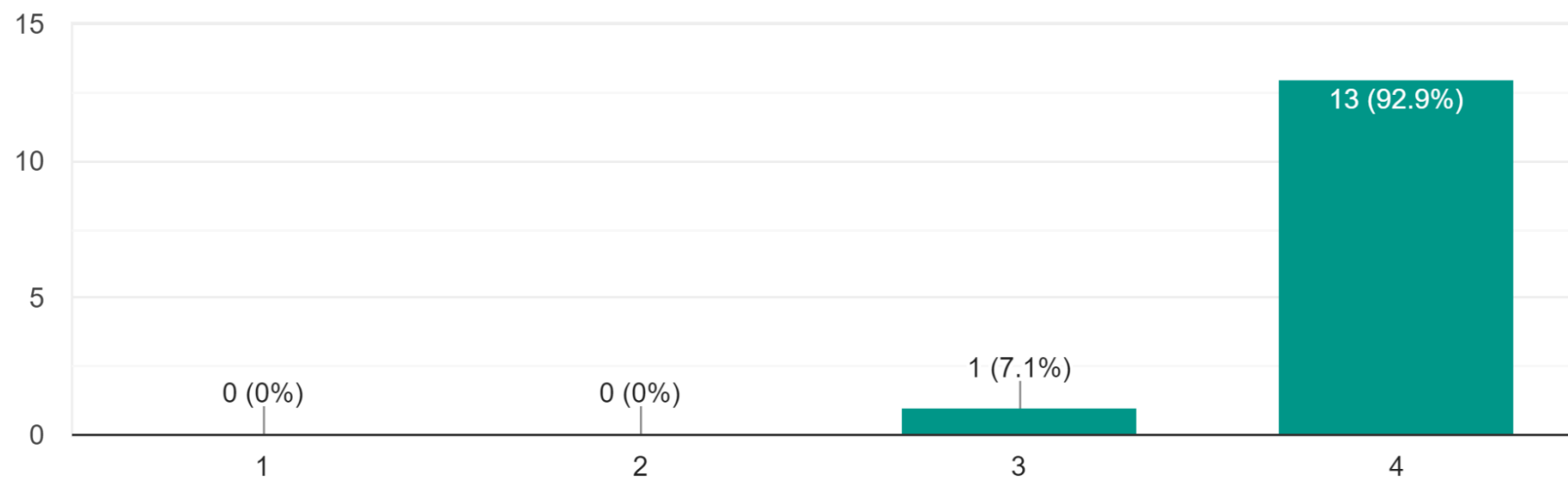

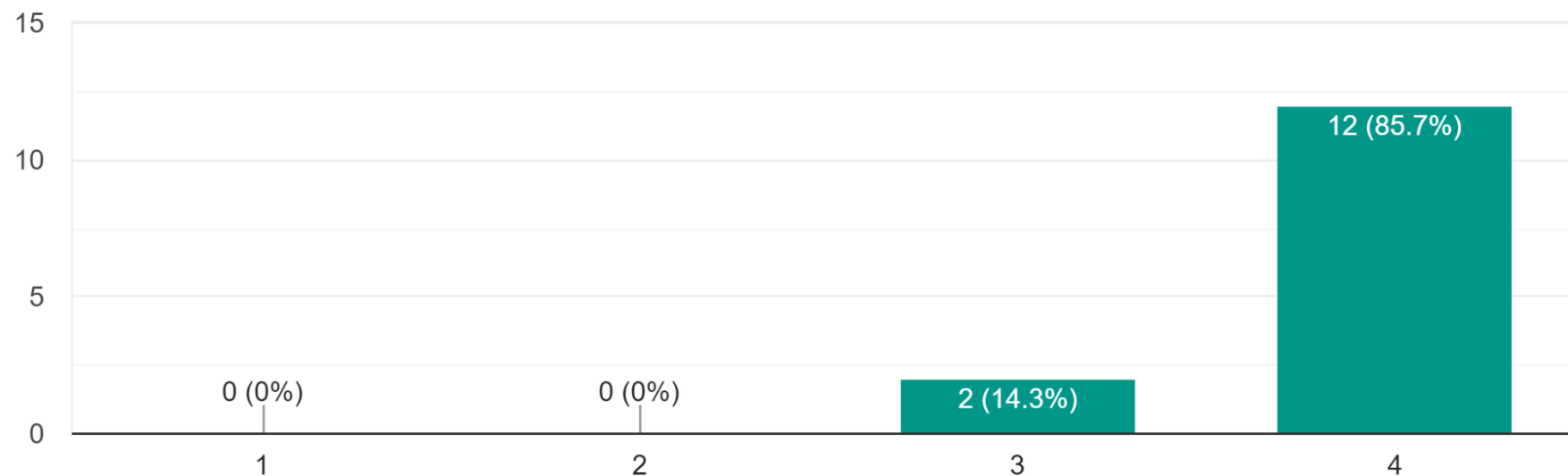

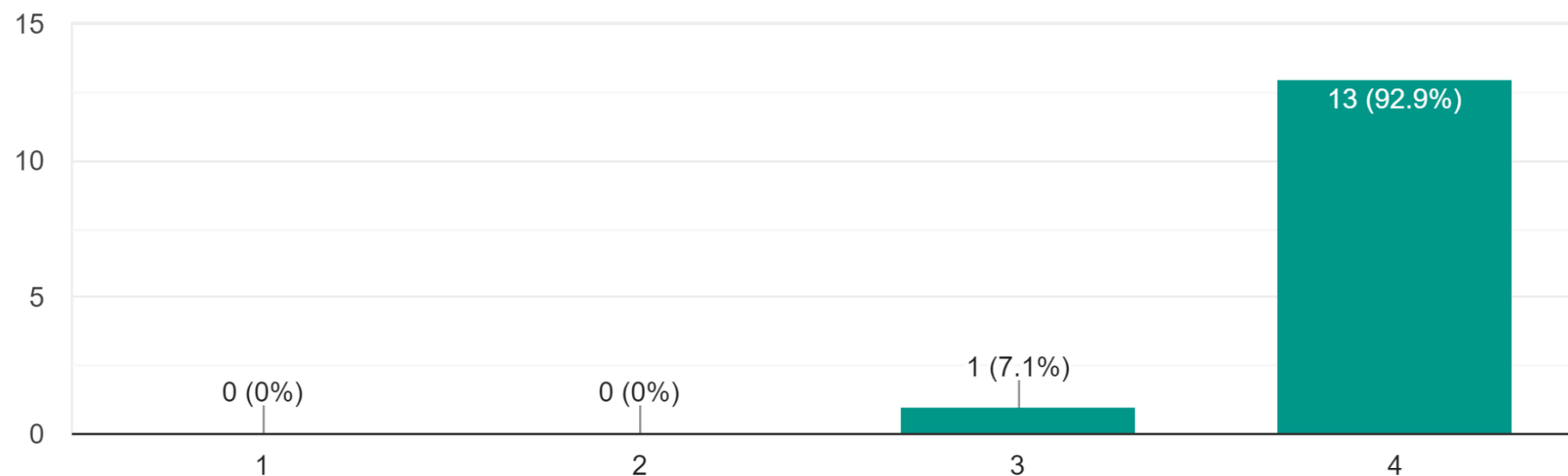

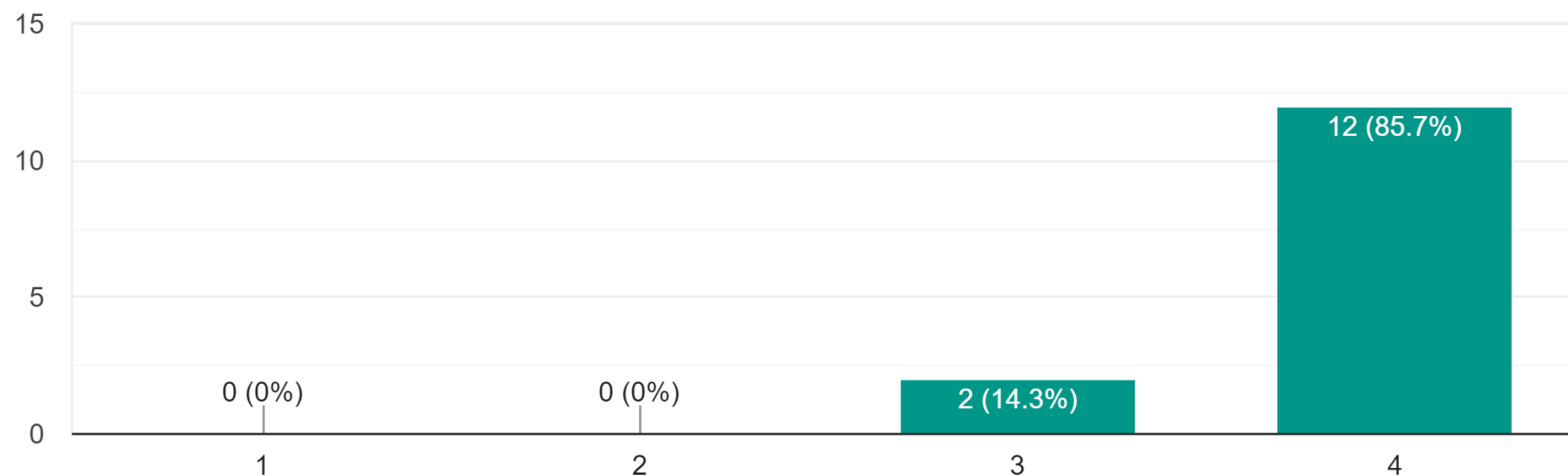

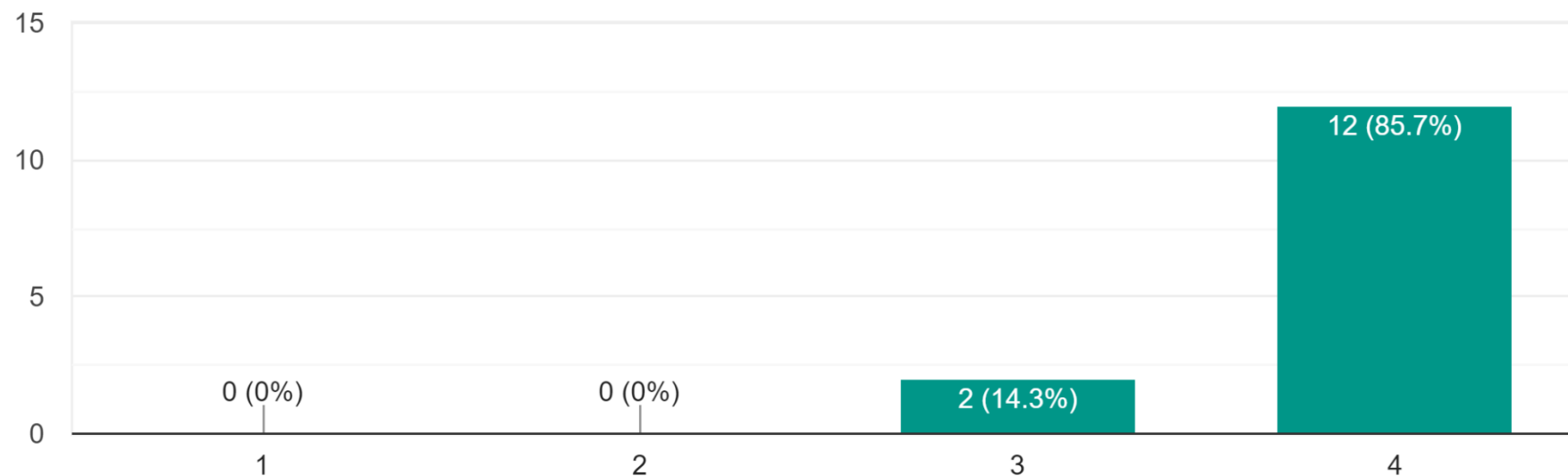

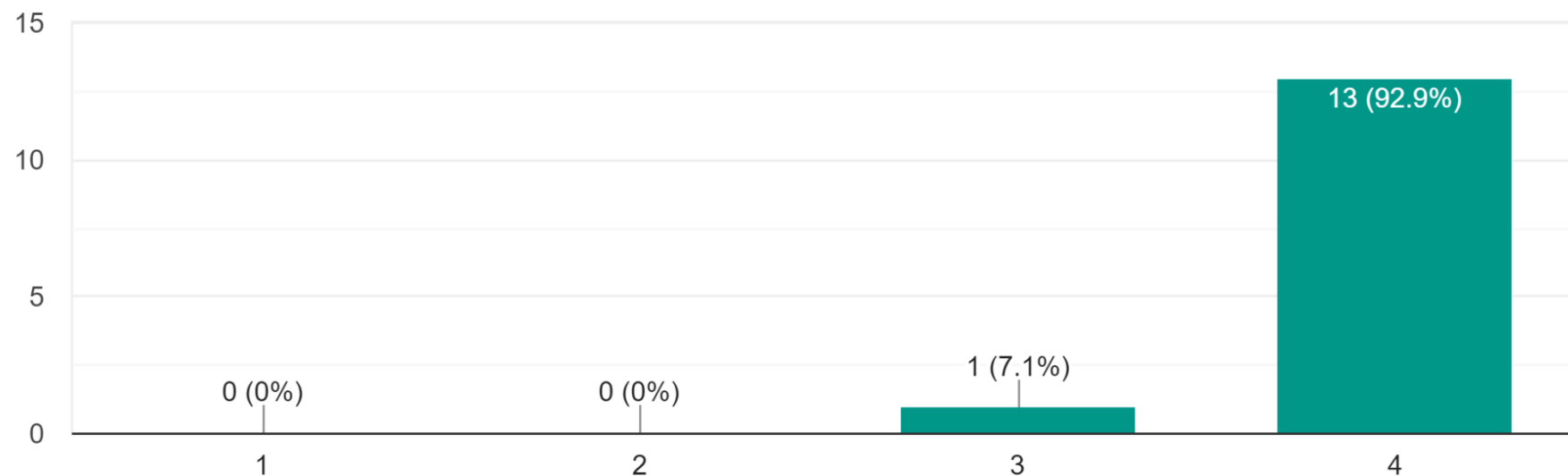

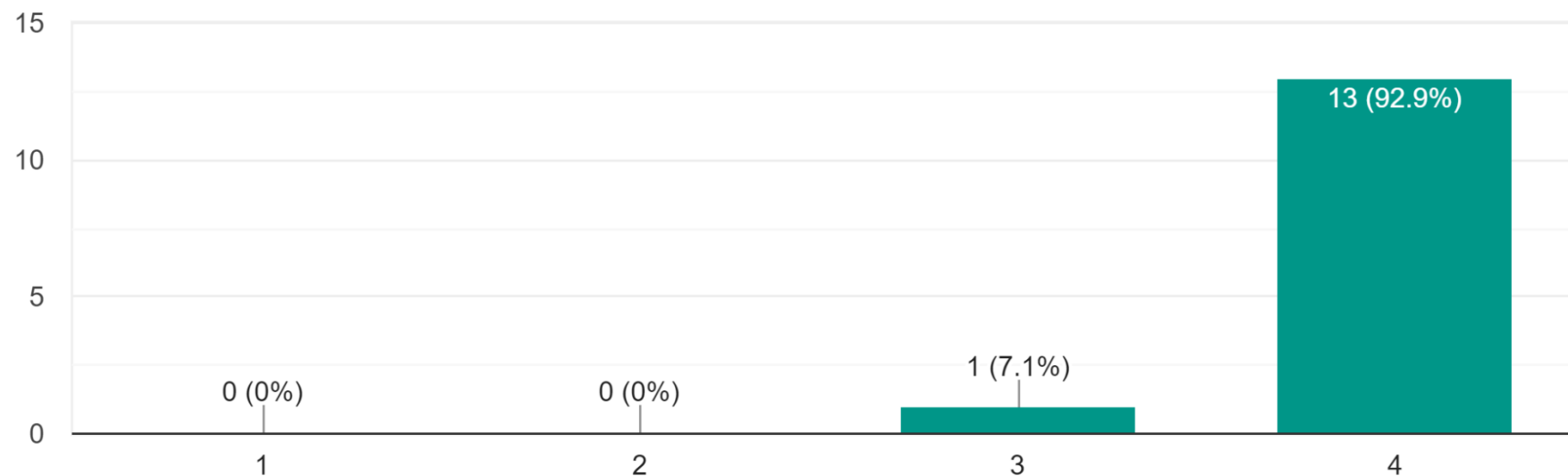

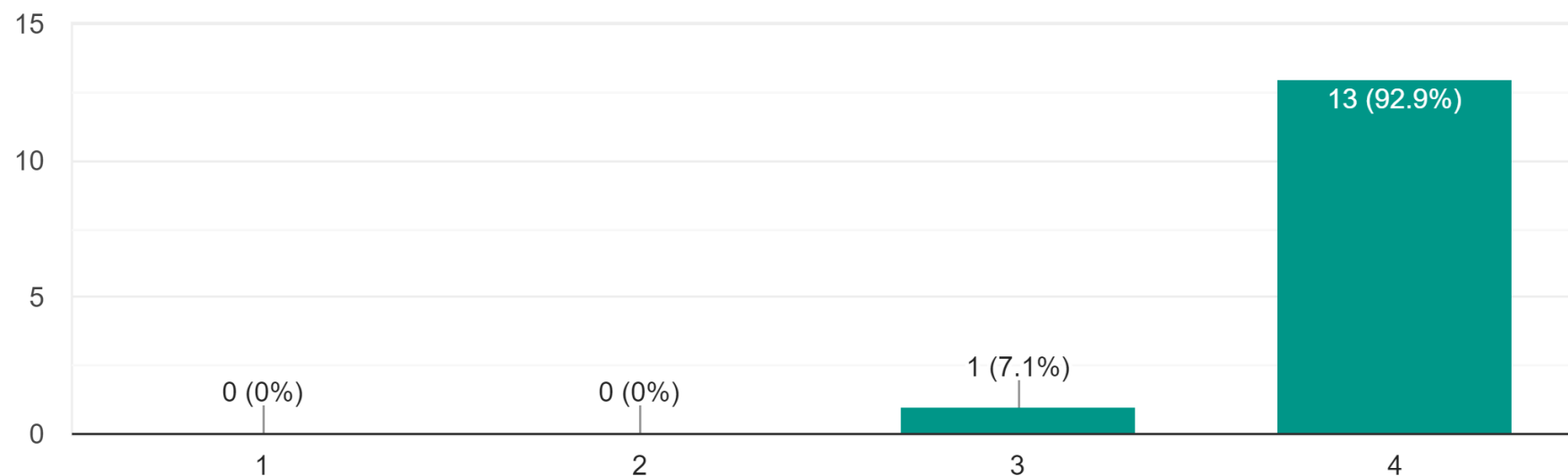

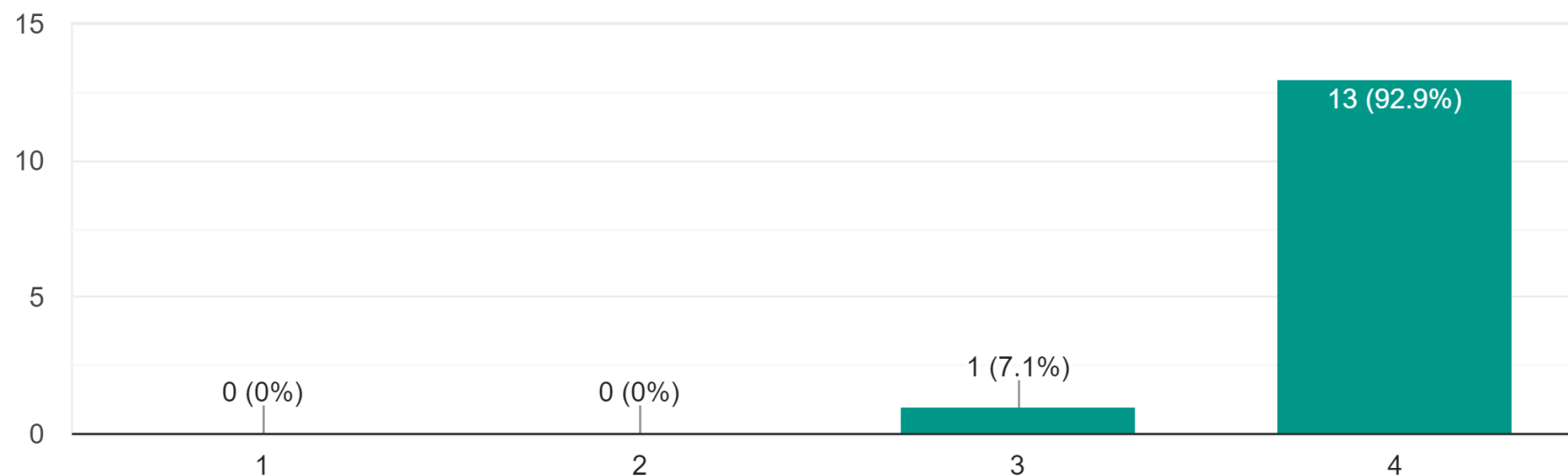

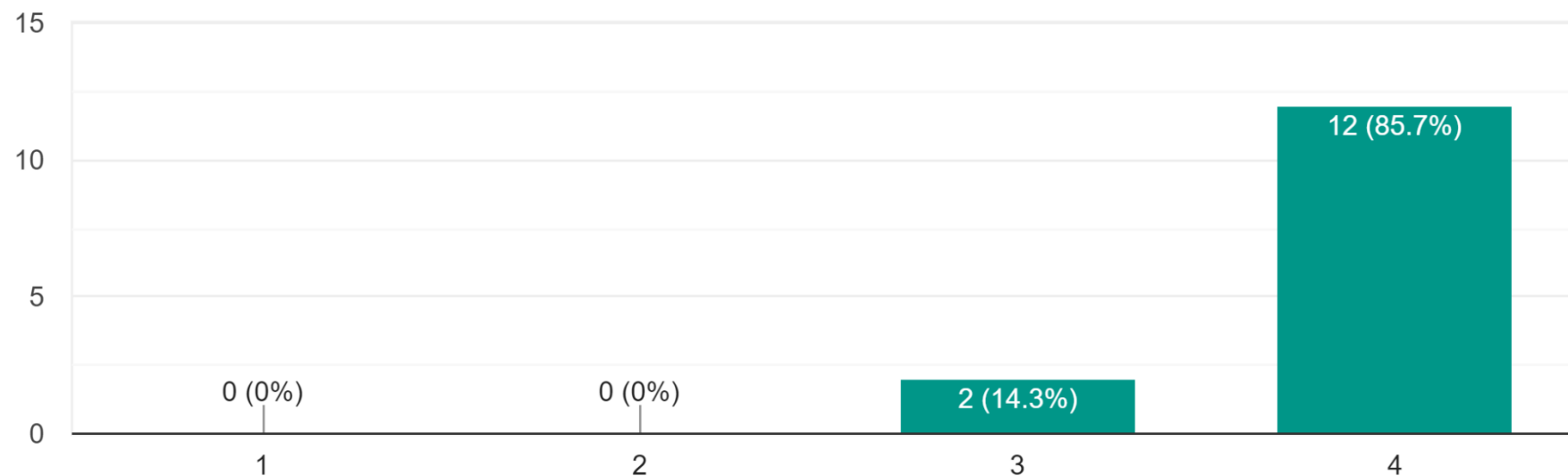

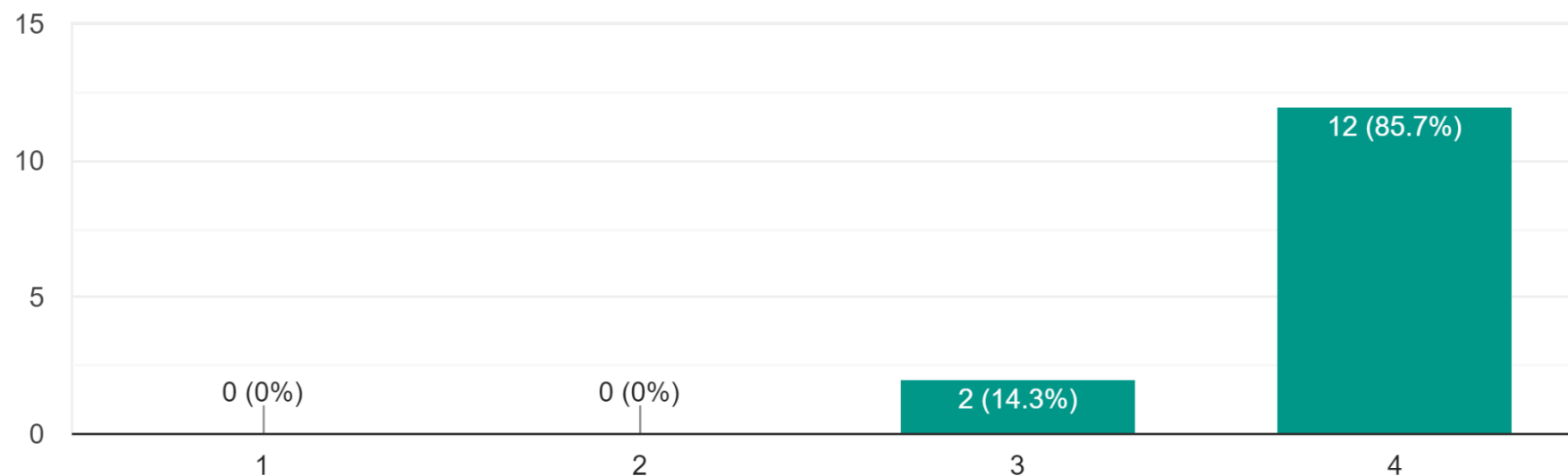
